- **4.** The graph is based on a survey of 41,500 campers. How many of the campers in the survey are African American?
- **5.** Can you use the graph to determine the likelihood that any random person participates in camping? Explain your reasoning.
- **6.** Explain how the education bar is different from the other four bars in the graph.



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
