## Analyzing a Budget

## EXAMPLE 5 Analyzing Annual Expenses

The circle graph shows the average annual expenses for a U.S. household, according to the Department of Labor. What percent of the expenses are spent on taxes and shelter?

## SOLUTION



The total of the expenses is $\$ 51,173$.

$$
\begin{aligned}
\frac{\text { Taxes }+ \text { Shelter }}{\text { Total expenses }} & =\frac{2104+10,075}{51,173} \\
& \approx 0.238 \\
& =23.8 \%
\end{aligned}
$$

In the Department of Labor's survey, the average household had 2.5 members and 1.3 wage earners.
