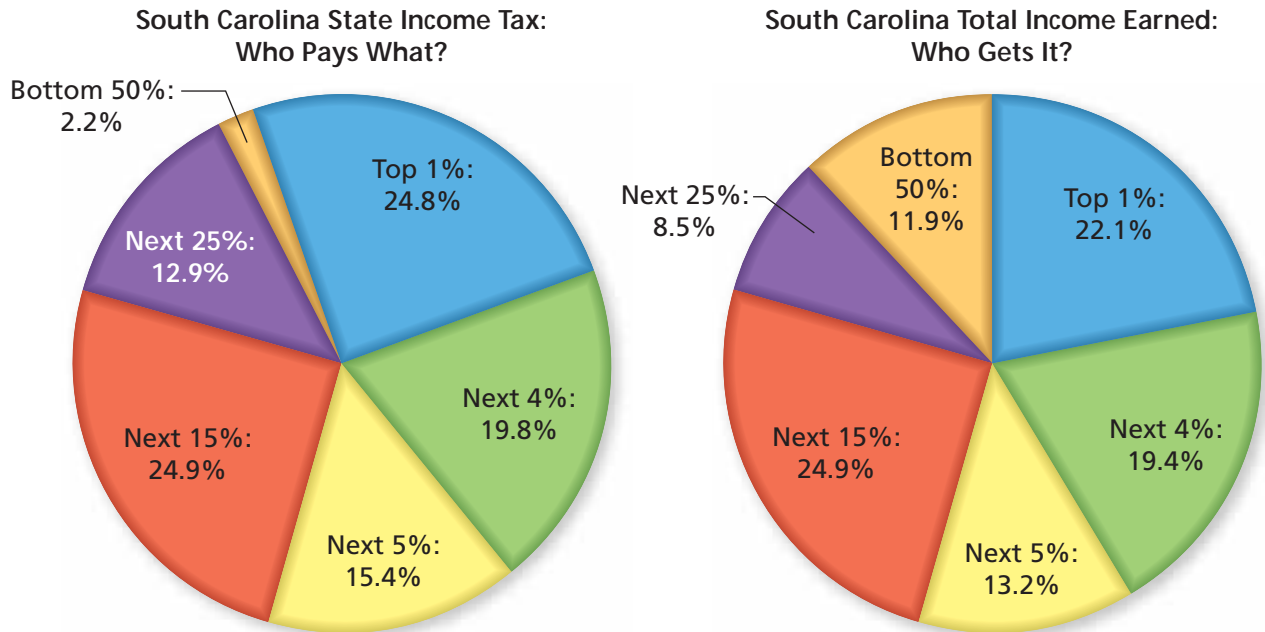


South Carolina State Income Tax In Exercises 7 and 8, use the circle graphs. (See Example 3.)
